The **Syriac alphabet** is a writing system primarily used to write the Syriac language from the 1st century AD. It is one of the Semitic abjads directly descending from the Aramaic alphabet and shares similarities with the Phoenician, Hebrew, Arabic, and the traditional Mongolian alphabets.

General remarks

Syriac is written from right to left. It is a cursive script where some, but not all, letters connect within a word. The alphabet consists of 22 letters, all of which are consonants. The vowel sounds are supplied by the reader's memory or by pointing (a system of diacritical marks to indicate the correct reading).

In fact, three letters act as matres lectionis: rather than being a consonant, they indicate a vowel. $\bar{A}la\bar{p}$ (1), the first letter, represents a glottal stop, but it can also indicate a vowel at the beginning or the end of a word. The letter Waw (o) is the consonant w, but can also represent the vowels o and w. Likewise, the letter $Y\bar{o}d$ (\mathbb{I}) represents the consonant v, but it also stands for the vowels v and v.

In addition to the sounds of the language, the letters of the Syriac alphabet can be used to represent numbers in a system similar to Hebrew and Greek numerals.

When Arabic began to be the dominant spoken language in the Fertile Crescent, texts were often written in Arabic with the Syriac script. These writings are usually called Karshuni or Garshuni (בלבגס, בב). Garshuni is often used today by Neo-Aramaic speakers in written communication such as letters and fliers.

Forms of the Syriac alphabet

There are three major variants of the Syriac alphabet.

Classical 'Estrangēlā

The oldest and classical form of the alphabet is 'Estrangēlā (ميدذ عدر); the name is thought to derive from the Greek adjective στρογγύλη (strongylē, 'rounded'), [1] though it has also been suggested to derive from مذير (serṭā 'ewangēlāyā, 'gospel character')^[2]). Although 'Estrangēlā is no longer used as the main script for writing Syriac, it has received some revival since the 10th century. It is often used in scholarly publications (for instance, the Leiden University version of the Peshitta), in titles



and inscriptions. In some older manuscripts and inscriptions it is possible for any letter to join to the left, and older Aramaic letter forms (especially of Heth and the lunate Mem) are found. Vowel marks are usually not used with 'Esţrangēlā.

East Syriac Madnhāyā

The East Syriac dialect is usually written in the Madnhāyā (בֹּאָבׁה, 'Eastern') form of the alphabet. Other names for the script include Swādāyā (), 'conversational', often translated as 'contemporary', reflecting its use in writing modern Neo-Aramaic), 'Assyrian' (not to be confused with the traditional name for the Hebrew alphabet), 'Chaldean', and, inaccurately, 'Nestorian' (a term that was originally used to refer to the Church of the East in the Persian Empire). The Eastern script resembles 'Estrangēlā more closely than the Western script, being somewhat a midway point between the two. The Eastern script uses a system of dots above or below letters, based on an older system, to indicate vowels:

- A dot above and a dot below a letter represent [a], transliterated as a or \check{a} ($\check{\mu}$, $P_{\underline{t}}\bar{a}h\bar{a}$),
- Two diagonally-placed dots above a letter represent [α], transliterated as \bar{a} or \hat{a} or \hat{a} (\hat{a}), $Zq\bar{a}p\bar{a}$),

- Two diagonally-placed dots below a letter represent [e], transliterated as ē (كُتْخَ لَ كُونْتُ لَ \$\diagonal \diagonal \d Lito, Zlāmā qašyā),

- A letter Waw with a dot above it represents [o], transliterated as ō or o (كُشِنِمَ لِكُونِيَكِ, 'Ṣāṣā rwīḥā or كَنْفَكَ, Rwāḥā).

• A combination of Rpāṣā karyā (usually) followed by a letter Yōd represents [e] (possibly *[e] in Proto-Syriac), transliterated as \bar{e} or \hat{e} (Lüö), $\check{A}s\bar{a}q\bar{a}$).

It is thought that the Eastern method for representing vowels influenced the development of the Niqqud markings used for writing Hebrew.

In addition to the above vowel marks, transliteration of Syriac sometimes includes θ , e or superscript e (or often nothing at all) to represent an original Aramaic schwa that became lost later on at some point in the development of Syriac. Some transliteration schemes find its inclusion necessary for showing spirantization (see below) or for historical reasons. Whether because its distribution is mostly predictable (usually inside a syllable-initial two-consonant cluster) or because its pronunciation was lost, neither the East nor West variants of the alphabet have a sign to represent the schwa.

West Syriac Sertā

The West Syriac dialect is usually written in the Sertā (كُوْلُورُكُ, 'line') form of the alphabet, also known as the $P \check{s} \bar{\iota} t \bar{a}$ () $\dot{\Sigma}$ $\dot{\Sigma}$ (simple), 'Maronite', or the 'Jacobite' script (although the Jacobite is term considered derogatory). Most of the letters are clearly derived from 'Estrangēlā, but simplified, flowing lines.

cursive, chancery hand is evidenced in the earliest Syriac manuscripts, but important works were written in Estrangēlā. From the 8th century, the simpler Serţā style came into fashion, perhaps because of its more economical use of parchment. The Nabataean alphabet (which gave rise to the Arabic alphabet) was based on this form of Syriac handwriting. The Western script is usually vowel-pointed with miniature Greek vowel letters above or below the letter which they follow:

- Capital Alpha (A) represents [a], transliterated as a or ă (كُنْمُ عُلِي Ptāḥā),
- Lowercase Alpha (α) represents [α], transliterated as \bar{a} or \hat{a} or \hat{a} (\vec{a}), $Zq\bar{a}p\bar{a}$; pronounced as [o] and transliterated as o in the West Syriac dialect),
- Lowercase Epsilon (ϵ) represents both [ϵ], transliterated as e or \check{e} , and [e], transliterated as \bar{e} ($\lambda = \bar{k} + \bar{k} = \bar{k} = \bar{k}$),

- Lowercase Omega (ω), used only in the vocative interjection \bar{o} (\circ), 'O!').

Summary table

The Syriac alphabet consists of the following letters, shown in their isolated (non-connected) forms. When isolated, the letters $K\bar{a}p\bar{p}$, $M\bar{\nu}m$, and $N\bar{\nu}m$ are usually shown with their initial form connected to their final form (see below). The letters 'Ālap̄, Dālat, Hē, Waw, Zayn, Ṣādē, Rēš, and Taw (and, in early 'Estrangēlā manuscripts, the letter Semkat^[3]) do not connect to a following letter within a word when written. These are marked with an asterisk (*).

Letter alterations

In modern usage, some alterations can be made to represent phonemes not represented in classical orthography. A mark similar in appearance to a tilde, called $Majl\bar{\imath}y\bar{a}n\bar{a}$ ($\bar{\alpha}$), is placed either above or below a letter in the $Madnh\bar{a}y\bar{a}$ variant of the alphabet to change its phonetic value (see also: Geresh):

- Added to Gāmal: [g] to [d3] (voiced postalveolar affricate)
- Added to $K\bar{a}p$: [k] to [\hat{t}] (voiceless postalveolar affricate)
- Added to Zayn: [z] to [3] (voiced postalveolar fricative)
- Added to *Šīn*: [ʃ] to [ʒ]

In addition to foreign sounds, a marking system is used to distinguish $q\bar{u}\bar{s}\bar{s}\bar{a}y\bar{a}$ (L5505, 'soft' letters). The letters $B\bar{e}\underline{t}$, $G\bar{a}mal$, $D\bar{a}la\underline{t}$, $K\bar{a}p\bar{p}$, $P\bar{e}$, and Taw, all plosives ('hard'), are able to be spirantized into fricatives ('soft'). The system involves placing a single dot underneath the letter to give its 'soft' variant and a dot above the letter to give its 'hard' variant (though, in modern usage, no mark at all is usually used to indicate the 'hard' value):

The mnemonic $b\bar{g}adk\bar{p}\bar{a}\underline{t}$ (c=4) is often used to remember the six letters that are able to be spirantized (see also: Begadkefat).

In the East Syriac variant of the alphabet, spirantization marks are usually omitted when they interfere with vowel marks. The degree to which letters can be spirantized varies from dialect to dialect as some dialects have lost the ability for certain letters to be spirantized. For native words, spirantization depends on the letter's position within a word or syllable, location relative to other consonants and vowels, gemination, etymology, and other factors. Foreign words are not always subject to the rules for spirantization.

Unicode

The Syriac alphabet was added to the Unicode Standard in September, 1999 with the release of version 3.0.
