Etymology

From Middle Persian 𐭠𐭮𐭥𐭥𐭥𐭥𐭥𐭥 (*Ahremen*), from Avestan 𐬀𐬎𐬌𐬎𐬭𐬀𐬎𐬎𐬎𐬎 (*aŋra mainyu*, “destructive spirit, destructive mind, etc.”).
