Etymology

From Middle Chinese 不空成就如來 (*pjuw khuwng dzyeng dzjuwH njo loj*). Compare modern Mandarin 不空成就佛 (*bùkōng chéngjiù fō*), exchanging 如來 (*rúlái*) for roughly synonymous 佛 (*fō*).

The Middle Chinese term itself is a compound of 不空成就 + 如來:

- 不空成就 is a translation of Sanskrit अमोघसिद्धि (*amoghasiddhi*), the name of this entity, and a compound of अमोघ (*amogha*, “not in vain”) + सिद्धि (*siddhi*, “perfection; accomplishment, attainment; success”).
- 如來 is an abbreviation of either 如去如來 or 如來如去 (“coming from suchness, going back into suchness”), translations of Sanskrit तथागत (*tathāgata*, “coming from suchness, going back into suchness; thus coming, thus going”, exact meaning uncertain, see 🌐 **Tathāgata** on Wikipedia.)^{[1][2]}.

不空成就如来 (*hiragana* ふくうじょうじゆによらい, *romaji* Fukūjōju Nyorai)

- (*religion, Buddhism*) Fukūjōju Nyorai: the Buddha of the North, called Amoghasiddhi; the embodiment of the accomplishment of the Buddhist path and the overcoming of envy, one of the Five Dhyani Buddhas, and an important entity in Shingon Buddhism

Coordinate terms

The 五智如来 (*Go Chi Nyorai*, “Five Dhyani Buddhas”) and associated directions are:

- 阿弥陀如来 (あみだによらい, *Amida Nyorai*): west
- 阿閼如来 (あしゆくによらい, *Ashuku Nyorai*): east
- 大日如来 (だいにちによらい, *Dainichi Nyorai*): center
- 不空成就如来 (ふくじょうじゆによらい, *Fukūjōju Nyorai*): north
- 宝生如来 (ほうしょうによらい, *Hōshō Nyorai*): south

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Amoghasiddhi

Amoghasiddhi is one of the Five Wisdom Buddhas of the Vajrayana tradition of Buddhism. He is associated with the accomplishment of the Buddhist path and of the destruction of the poison of envy. His name means *He Whose Accomplishment Is Not In Vain*. His Shakti/consort is Tara, meaning *Noble Deliverer* or *Noble Star* and his mounts are garudas. He belongs to the family of Karma whose family symbol is the Double vajra/thunderbolt.^{[1][2]}

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Characteristics

Amoghasiddhi is associated with the conceptual skandha or the conceptual mind (as opposed to the non-conceptual or sensational mind). His action towards the promotion of Buddhist paths is the pacification of evils. This is symbolised by Amoghasiddhi's symbol, the moon. He gestures in the mudra of fearlessness, symbolising his and his devotees' fearlessness towards the poisons or delusions.

He is usually coloured green in artwork and is associated with the air or wind element. His season is summer and his heavenly quarter, the north.
