

Angels, Visions and Holograms

Many 'unexplainable phenomena', like visions, are not limited to the bible pages. We have visions in the sky, voices that could be heard along great distances, lights stronger than the Sun, flying vehicles, hailstones from heaven and many other events all over the world. Surprisingly, only Jews, Christians and Moslems associate visions with God and angels. Since the messengers of Enlil/Yahweh could fly using helicopter-like vehicles, the angels are also supposed to have the same ability. Their wings, however, is a later invention of a rather artistic nature. This invention was necessary in order to erase the presence of technological equipment. We believe that the biblical visions were the work of the members of the Brotherhood of the Gold, alias Yahweh and members of his family.

We have 'signs in the sky' every now and then, often appearing at the time of some important person's birth. We have such signs when Abraham was born, Apollonius of Tyana, Osiris, Jesus, Buddha and others, suggesting that those who had access to the required technical equipment freely exercised this kind of medial communication. From the Egyptian Mythology (the Story of Isis and Osiris by April McDevitt), we read: 'When Osiris was born many signs and wonders were seen and heard throughout the world. Most notable was the voice which came from the holiest shrine in the temple at Thebes on the Nile, which today is called Karnak, speaking to a man called Pamyles bidding him proclaim to all men that Osiris, the good and mighty king, was born to bring joy to all the earth.' Osiris was the firstborn son of Marduk/Ra and his earthly wife Serpanit. He was probably the greatest civilizer on Earth. He and his wife Isis were two of the most admirable demigods ever. Their cult has been functioning for over three thousand years and the last Temples destroyed by Christian fanatics as late as the 5th century CE. Osiris wandered all over the earth civilizing mankind armed neither with weapons nor with doctrines but with music and good advises. It is worthy to note that since Osiris was killed and 'resurrected' like Jesus, he is considered as symbolizing the rebirth of nature, while Jesus is considered as immortal. Not only visions and angels are coming down from heaven but also a whole city.

Revelations 21:2: 'And I John saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as bride adorned for her husband'. The messengers were members of the alien mission to obtain gold on Earth, some of them members of the Jehovah family. In the Bible they have different abilities well in accordance with their different education and skills. They can fly in 'whirlwinds', 'sky ships' or with the help of some equipment attached to their bodies. Athena had sandals allowing her to fly as well as Hermes and Horus. Inanna (Aphrodite) and Ninurta/Ares had their own 'sky bird' armed with missiles. The higher members of the 'Gold Mission Corporation' are called archangels in the Bible while ordinary members are called angels and sometimes even 'men'!

The angels who visited Abraham before the destruction of the military base on mount Sinai, Sodom, Gomorra and the other cities of the plain, were Ninurta and Nergal according to 'the Lost Book of Enki' by Z. We wrote about the corruption of our early history where Sumerian and Babylonian 'documents' had been changed in order to fit the doctrine of the only God. It seems that the corruption never ended!

The angels do not always kill people or destroy cities. They often have some message to pass down to their agents and they even use drugs to make them understand and remember the message, like the angel who visited Ezekiel.

Ezekiel 3:2-3: 'So I opened my mouth, and he caused me to eat that roll. And he said unto me, Son of man, cause thy belly to eat, and fill thy bowels with this roll that I give thee. Then did I eat it; and it was in my mouth as honey for sweetness'. Revelations 10:9: 'And I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book. And he said unto me, Take it, and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey'. We admit that we do not know if there is some benevolent being we could call 'the Creator of All'. The Christian bible claims that he not only exists but his angels also make use of drugs.

Sometimes the angels were 'illustrious' or 'shining' so the scribes could immediately recognize them as the messengers of god. But sometimes they appeared as quite ordinary people.

Joshua 5:13-15: 'And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted up his eyes and looked, and, behold, there stood a man over against him with his sword drawn in his hand: and Joshua went unto him, and said unto him, Art thou for us, or for our adversaries? And he said, Nay; but as captain of the host of the LORD am I now come. And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and did worship, and said unto him, What saith my Lord unto his servant? And the captain of the LORD's host said unto Joshua, Loose thy shoe from off thy foot; for the place whereon thou standest is holy. And Joshua did so. 'Note that Joshua assumes that the man was one of his own or perhaps one of his enemies. But nay, he was the commander of the army immediately accepted by Joshua! The fact that Joshua assumed that the angel could be one of the enemies, Anakim was one of the enemies, witnesses that the Anakim were not giants as the Bible claims but perfectly ordinary looking people. Although he informs Joshua that the place is now 'holy', he does not explain why, and Joshua takes off his shoes! The messenger is probably the archangel Michael, the great religion-architect.

The Christians do not take off their shoes before entering the church (holy place) but the Moslems do. As we have seen, Michael was the moon god Nannar/Sin; the son of Enlil/Yahweh and his emblem was the crescent moon that later became the symbol of Islam. In Christian churches Nannar/Michael appears faceless on icons because the rumors states that only the dead can see his face. St. Michael is, according to Christian doctrines, occupied by collecting the souls of the dead. In 'The Gold Mission' So Far No Good, we have seen how and why Enlil/Yahweh created a unique army under the forty years in the desert. The reiterated instructions to the agents, the many visions at different times and the great efforts of Enlil/Yahweh and his warriors witness of a plan spanning much longer than our lives. Never before have these winged angels been so admired and so popular. Their own book, however, the Christian Bible, is full of their criminal actions against humanity and against individuals. The description that they are the 'spirits of God' can never revoke their guilty. The Christian Bible is full of their criminal actions as 'the agents of the evil god Jehovah'.
