'Arif 'Alī-Šāh or *Arif Ali-Shah*

Omar Ali Shah, the elder brother of Idries Shah, died last week (September 2nd) in Spain, 83 years old.

Born in Afghanistan in 1922, son to the renowned Sirdar Ikbal Ali Shah, he was raised in the Sufi tradition by members of his Hashemite family and received formal education in Britain, where he used to live in his later days. As a young man he acted sometimes as his father representative before heads of state and in other diplomatic issues. He joined the military, was part of an Afghan contingent in the Corea war and retired as a NATO general.

At the moment of his death Shah was a Sufi Sheikh, heading a large constituency of disciples in several Western countries, both in Europe and the Americas.

His son Arif Shah, currently living in Chile, is expected to be appointed as his successor.

The friend goes on to say "It was announced today that Arif has assumed leadership of the tariqa in accordance with his father's wishes. Both a fax from Arif and an old "fatwa" written by Agha last year was sent out to the Friends with this information."

In the event of my death it is my solemn wish and Command that all friends of the Tradition shall recognize my son Syed Hashim Arif Ali-Shah as my successor and that he may appoint Advisors or Councillors as he may desire.

I Command that you should give to Syed Arif, carrying as he does the Baraka of the Silsilah, the respect you gave to me and that the structure and activities of the Tradition as laid down by me should continue as before.

May Almighty God bless you all.

Dear Friends

This is to confirm that, in accordance with the last wishes of my father, Sayed Omar Ali-Shah, I undertake to continue his work to protect, nurture and advance the work of the Tradition - this work which is vital to humanity.

As did my father, I count with your support and efforts along this road, and you may count with mine.


This work is already continuing. I will ask for nothing more than that which my father asked of you all: hard work in humility and to trust in the Lord for his patience and love.
