## בֵּית־תְּאֵנָה

### BETHANY

From the name of a biblical town, possibly derived from Hebrew [בֵּית־תְּאֵנָה](#) (*beit-te'edah*) meaning "house of figs". In the [New Testament](#) the town of Bethany was the home of Lazarus and his sisters Mary and Martha. It has been in use as a rare given name in the English-speaking world since the 19th century, used primarily by Catholics in honour of Mary of Bethany. In America it became moderately common after the 1950s.
