Bhūmi

Bhūmi (Sanskrit: भूमि), also **Bhūmī-Devī** (Sanskrit: भूमि देवी), **Bhuma-Devi** or **Bhū-Devī**, is the personification of Mother Earth. She is the consort of **Varaha**, an avatar of **Vishnu** and regarded as the mother of the goddess **Sita**. According to the *uttara-kanda*, when **Sita** finally leaves her husband **Rama**, she returns to **Bhumidevi**. She is the mother of the demon **Narakasura**.^[1] **Bhumi Devi** is also believed to be one of the two forms of **Lakshmi**. The other is **Sridevi**, who remains with **Narayana**. **Bhudevi** is the Goddess of Earth, and the fertility form of **Lakshmi**. She is the daughter of **Kashyap Prajapati**. According to some she is also **Satyabhama**, wife of **Sri Krishna** in *Dwapara Yuga* and the divine saint **Andal**. Several female deities have had births similar to **Sita**. **Alamelu Mangamma** or **Sri Padmavathi Devi** of **Tiruchanur** had a similar beginning, being found in a ploughed field by **Akasa Raja**. **Andal** from **Srivilliputtur** in **Tamil Nadu** was found under a **Tulasi** plant by **Periyaalvar**.

1 Iconography

Click! Vivasvan, Rahu, Bhūmi, Naraka, Ananta, Garbhodaksayi Vishnu

She is depicted in votive statuary, seated on a square platform which rests on the back of four elephants representing the four directions of the world. When depicted with four arms, she holds a pomegranate, a water vessel, a bowl containing healing herbs, and another containing vegetables.^[2] When shown with two arms, she holds a blue lotus known as **Komud** or **Uttpal** the night lotus, in the right hand.^[3] The left hand may be in the **Abhaya Mudra** - fearlessness or the **Lolahasta Mudra** which is an aesthetic pose meant to mimic the tail of a cow.^[4]
