Teaching Notes - Breath Prayer

"Think of prayer as the breath in our lungs and the blood from our hearts. Our blood flows and our breathing continues 'without ceasing'; we are not even conscious of Jesus keeping us in perfect oneness with God but if we are obeying Him, He always is. Prayer is not an exercise; it is the life of the saint. Beware of anything that stops the offering up of prayer. Maintain the childlike habit of offering up prayer in your heart to God all the time." Oswald Chambers (MY UTMOST FOR HIS HIGHEST)

Based on the Scripture of when Jesus breathed a prayer on the disciples, breath prayers are in essence a pause to take in a breath of God. The idea is to say a prayer that is short enough to be said in one breath. Physically when you say a full breath prayer it causes your body to reach into the lower lungs and expel all the air, the immediate uncontrolled response to this is a deep full reaching breath that fills all the longs. The physiological affects of this deep cleansing breath include, calming the nervous system and slowing the heart beat. Your breath prayer can be as simple as pausing to take a deep breath and exhaling the prayer or full body language may be added, raising hands, palms up to God, bowing head, etc. To keep our focus on the Lord, I recommend breath prayers be the direct words of scripture. I have included some of my favorites below.

- Breathe in deep breath
- Breathe Prayer
- Breathe in (receive from the Lord)
- Breathe out (exhale worldly cares, junk)
