Haziël ("vision of God")—a cherub invoked to obtain the pity of God. Haziël is one of 72 angels bearing the mystical name of God Shem-hamphorae (*see* Appendix). When equated with Bernael (*q.v.*), he is an angel of darkness. For Haziël's sigil, see Ambelain, *La Kabbale Pratique*, p. 260. [*Rf. Falasha Anthology.*] In I Chronicles 23:9 Haziël is a mortal, an offspring of the Gershonites. The cabalists very likely drew the name from this source.
