Haziel ("vision of God")—a cherub invoked to obtain the pity of God. Haziel is one of 72 angels bearing the mystical name of God Shemhamphorae (see Appendix). When equated with Bernael (q.v.), he is an angel of darkness. For Haziel's sigil, see Ambelain, La Kabbale Pratique, p. 260. [Rf. Falasha Anthology.] In I Chronicles 23:9 Haziel is a mortal, an offspring of the Gershonites. The cabalists very likely drew the name from this source.
