

Damian (given name)

Damian, also spelled Damien, Daymian, Daymein, Дамиан (Damian), Damiano, Дамјан (Damjan), Damião, Дамян (Damyan), Демьян (Demyan), etc., is a given name from the Latin **Damianus** which is the latinisation of the Greek **Δαμιανός** (**Damianos**), derived from the Greek word δαμάζω (*damazo*), "to conquer, master, overcome, tame", in the form of δαμάω/-ώ (*damao*), a form assumed as the 1st pers. of δαμᾶ (*dama*). Notable persons with the name include:

- Damian of Ephesus, [4] Greek rhetorician
- Damian of Thessalonica, Greek physician
- Sts. Cosmas and Damian (died c.303), early Christian martyrs, patrons of physicians and surgeons
- Saint Damian of Alexandria, an early Christian martyr
- Coptic Pope Damian of Alexandria (died 605)
- Damianus (died 669), a bishop of Rochester, named after one of the above martyrs
- Damian of Pavia (d. 710), Bishop of Pavia and saint
- Damian of Tarsus (d. 924), Byzantine renegade and Muslim admiral
- Pedro Damiano (1480-1544), a Portuguese chess player
- Blessed Damien of Moloka'i (1840-1889), a Roman Catholic missionary to the leper colony on the Hawaiian island of Moloka'i, revered for his ministry that resulted in his own death from leprosy.
