Revisiting Visions of Wilkerson, White

In 1974, David Wilkerson published "The Vision" in which he said, "The United States is going to experience...the biggest most disastrous earthquake in history...<u>Another</u> earthquake <u>possibly in</u> <u>Japan</u> may precede the one that I see coming here." <u>Wikipedia</u> lists numerous prophecies of Wilkerson, and three that failed.

In 1909, **Ellen White** published "The Last Crisis" in which she visited NYC and in vision saw tall buildings "warranted to be fireproof," but on the following page, said they were "consumed as if made of pitch. The fire engines could do nothing to stay the destruction." That article on 9-11 was published in <u>Vol</u> **9**, pages **11**-13 of *Testimonies for the Church.*

Clues in the same book point to <u>a major US earthquake</u> that coincides with FEMA's plans:

"<u>NLE 2011 will simulate</u> the catastrophic nature of a major earthquake" (link to FEMA)

FEMA's plans for a drill reminds us that the subway in London was bombed during a drill, as was a train in Madrid, Spain. FEMA was in NYC for a drill on 9-11 and there are unanswered questions about how fireproof buildings could come down so fast. (You can click colored text)

NASA's Ames Center reported 100 earthquakes 5.0 or higher in Dec, 2001 and "nearly all" had electro-magnetic patterns consistent with HAARP. And now <u>Homeland Security</u> plans a National Level Exercise in the New Madrid area where the birds and fish died mysteriously and where

1. Get Outside if You Can.

The above link has the usual information like don't stay under a doorway or table--get next to one, but if you can get outside quickly, that's first choice. Mobile homes and cars are safe. Most houses would not be a life threat.

2. Most info says to lie down next to a

desk short bookcase or filing cabinet. **Better yet**, keep a water jug in your tub and get in the tub; you may need the water and the tub sides and bath room walls are protective.

3. Think spiritually. Ask the Creator God


to save you. Thank Him for water and ask for the water of life. Thank Him for the tub and ask Him to clean you inside. This is not saying you have to be religious or join a church, but seek God and truth--open the Bible and be open to its truths without focusing on denominations..

"Shall we wait until God's judgments fall on the transgressor before we tell him how to avoid them? Where is our faith in the word of God?" Ellen White, 9*Testimonies*, p20.

God has allowed many bad events by evil men in a world where all have free choice. This life is not all there is. For those who suffer wrongfully, God can make it up to them in the next life. Others, in dying, may repent as they seek rightness with God.

4. "Watching" is Protective: God can spare those who take prudent action while trusting in Him.

Christ said, "If the goodman had known, he would have watched and not suffered his house to be broken by the thief," Matt 24:43. The Savior linked watching with protection and He also said, "If you do not watch, I will come on you as a thief," Rev 3:3.



A time of Judgment is announced for endtime in <u>Revelation 14:6,7</u> with the everlasting gospel, the good news

"The Everlasting Gospel" that is announced in Revelation 14:6 is a changing good news to meet our needs in any circumstance...

1. In Noah's time, the gospel meant a provision to save man from **destruction** but most didn't believe it.

2. For Abraham, the good news was **real estate**, but some of his seed still wonder if God will do it.

3. Moses offered freedom from **bondage**, but they were afraid of giants.

4. Christ brought **salvation from sin**, but it didn't seem like good news.

5. The final generation will see a gospel that embraces **all of the above** issues without the buts...

A. The song of Moses and the Lamb (Rev 15) suggests liberation both physically and spiritually

B. "As in the days of Noah" implies escaping destruction.

C. When no man can buy or sell without a mark in this country, the land that God gave to Abraham and his seed could have freedom for sabbatarians. Ezek 36:24-28 and Jer 31:1,8,10,17,31-33.

These examples support that God is able to meet the broader needs of the end-times that are impending.

This includes sparing our lives in a time of judgment when we do the best we know to comply with His word that includes "watch and pray" as explained in the center column on the eve of Passover or 2nd Passover, May 18/19.

This 2nd Passover was provided for people in contact with a dead body or in a far journey, both of which apply to most Christians.

We might not like to think so, but for most churches, Christ is outside knocking (Rev 3:20) which means we have had contact with a [dead] church body, at least to some extent, are also in a "far journey" as we come back to biblical truth. Matt 17:11.

The time of judgment that's now beginning will sooner or later be a life and death matter for us as it was to Daniel. This is why Christ said to read and understand his book when asked about the end.

Earthquake May 26? Bible Clues

White's Earthquake Vision Excerpts: "During a vision of the night ...I could see houses shaken like a reed in the wind. Buildings great and small were falling to the ground...Many lives were blotted out..." ibid, p 92,93.

White's comments focused on Scripture: "Through His prophet Zephaniah, the Lord specifies the judgments that He will bring...'I will consume man and beast; I will consume the <u>fowls</u> and the <u>fishes</u>..." 9T 95. The dead birds and fish may mark this year. Miners used canaries in mines as a <u>26:38-41</u>), because God is "no respecter of persons."

God can protect us in response to compliance as He did for his people in Egypt, sparing those who put the blood of a lamb on their doorpost. We don't have to kill lambs or put blood on the door, but Christ offers a rich promise to those who are watching when He comes (Luke 12:37) and the imagery of that verse is the Last Supper/Passover. The above information shows it's 2nd Passover, May 19.

Please plan to watch and pray on the evening of May 18, and if May 19 is HUGE, visit this website again for information in the next column on how we make a covenant with God.

Honoring Christ's request to watch commemorates the greatest night of Old and New Testaments. Both nights focused on God's plan to deliver man from bondage (physical and spiritual).

A "Kit" with food, water and some batteries for flashlight and cell phones may be all you need, but why not consider what <u>Ready.gov</u> is recommending?

6. "An out-of-town contact...may be in a better position to communicate among separated family members." Have a <u>plan</u>.

Note the similarity to Christ's words that could be understood as a warning to flee when you see military [martial law?] "standing where it ought not," Mark 13:14

safety index, but we are so numb with sensational news that we shrug off whales beaching themselves or birds falling out of the sky when **HAARP** electromagnetic waves could be the cause, see above.

"The great day of the Lord is near...a day of darkness and gloominess, a day of clouds and thick darkness." Zeph 1:15. (cited in same book as her 9-11 vision, page 95.)

May 19, 1780 was a historic Dark Day that fits this description. Men quit work at mid-day and women lit lamps in an unexplained darkness that they took as a sign of the apocalypse. See pg 306 on this link--

Perhaps God was marking

May 19 when the 200th anniversary was another dark day after Mt St Helens erupted on the 18th and wind put ash over three states. It might be easy to ignore the "Dark Day," but Christ also said, "the sun shall be darkened..." as a sign of impending events, Mark 13:24.

This year May 19 falls on another biblical timeline that is misunderstood due to translation of an idiom. Christians often quote Christ's saying that you don't know the day or hour for events, but <u>the</u> <u>Greek word for "know" is eido</u>. It means to consider or understand. Christ was saying, You don't understand, or It's not like you think.

Christ gave several examples of a provision in their law for Passover (time of judgment) to be a month later, "as in the days of Noah," when destruction came with

Passover timing, but in the 2nd spring month. Passover can come on any day, but this year

it's on April 19, and 2nd Passover (suggested by Num 9:10,11) falls on <u>May 19</u>.

Astrology is not a science, but Googling "19, numerology" finds <u>Rising Sun or Prince of</u> <u>Heaven</u>, reminiscent of Lucifer, "son of the morning," Isaiah 14:12. Lucifer was cast out of heaven (Rev 12:9) for rebellion and his attempt to grab power. Since Satan claims 19 and homage from sun worship, God may have put dark days on May 19 as a marker for when dark forces would try to grab power?

Dark Day for Israel? It may be significant that Obama's picked May 19 to "throw Israel under the bus" as some legislators said. His intent to roll borders back to 1967 and leave Israel without defensible borders would be suicide and an introduction to what is prophetic in Zechariah 14, verses 1,2 with the earthquake coming in verses 4,5.

The biggest earthquake in US

history was 200 years ago and another one is impending...May 19 was the start of Passover week (seven days of unleavened bread, Lev 23:6) but "as the days of Noah," the Flood didn't start until <u>the end of a week</u>. 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Reasons for no rapture before the 2nd coming!

Many scholars are no longer convinced...

The rapture is <u>not</u> clearly taught in the Bible and because of this, <u>it's easy to</u> <u>jump to a mistaken conclusion</u>. For example, Christ says that "when He comes and knocks," we should "open to Him immediately." Luke 12:36. If you have been taught to believe in a rapture, it may be easy to think that's what Christ means here. But several points don't fit rapture teaching. Why would Christ say, "Have your loins girded, have your lights burning" if He were going to rapture us, even from sleep? We don't need to sleep with our clothes or lights on. This is about something else.

- When Christ said, "One shall be taken, and the other left" (Matthew 24:39-40), He wasn't talking about a rapture. Luke gives more details. The disciples asked, "Where, Lord? And He said unto them, Wheresoever the body is, there will the eagles be gathered." (Luke 17:37). With this additional information, it suggests that those who are *taken* are not raptured to heaven; they become the dinner for vultures. "One shall be taken and the other left" should not be understood as a rapture.
- A pre-tribulation rapture is contrary to God's way of dealing throughout history. History supports that "we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom." Acts 14:22. Our belief that it won't happen to us is based on a few texts that can be explained to mean something else. Everyone in history lived through trouble and died, except for Enoch and Elijah (discussed below).
- 3. Christ said, "As it was in the days of Noah" (Luke 17:26). Noah wasn't raptured; he came through the storm. Enoch was raptured before Noah was even born, so his being taken to heaven had nothing to do with avoiding the Flood or tribulation.
- 4. Elijah was raptured, but Christ never said the end would be like Elijah for us. Elijah was raptured only after he confronted false worship of Baal. Our confrontation will be with Antichrist when the United Nations mandates everyone to be marked or implanted for identity purposes, but this will be contrary to the Bible, Revelation 13:16,17; 14:9,10.
- "As it was in the days of Lot," Luke 17:28. Lot wasn't raptured, he was told to flee, and Christ told us to flee because there would be great tribulation, Matthew 24:15-21; Mark 13:14-20.
- 6. Everyone else in history has faced trouble and death. "Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples, and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come," 1Corinthians 10:11.
- 7. When asked about the end of the world, Christ said to understand Daniel. The book of Daniel shows no rapture. Daniel and his friends were tested by a series of life and death situations. "Daniel" means God is my Judge and we may only be judged when we face death and do right. Otherwise we may be "fair-weather" Christians.
- 8. Christ was in the furnace with the three Hebrews. "Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you," 1 Peter 4:12. God will be with us through the trials.
- 9. "Broad is the way, that leads to destruction." Matthew 7:13. Millions of rapture books sold like "Left Behind" suggest a broad following that does not fit well with the Bible's teaching that "we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God," Acts 14:22.
- 10. "By their fruits ye shall know them." The fruit of rapture teaching is a lack of Bible study in Revelation, thinking "we won't be around." But Revelation is the only book that Christ promises a

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Harold Camping's Heralds A Tribute to Thousands and a "Heads Up!"

<u>Summary</u>: A fatal error is canceled by a redemptive one that ends up nearly right. Revelation 1:3. Revelation uses symbols and imagery that we can decode from other parts of Scripture if we study and become familiar with the Bible.

11. We would feel like second class citizens in heaven if we were raptured from trouble and lukewarm materialism (Revelation 3:17) if we did not have the opportunity to face trouble manfully as did Daniel, Peter or Paul

12. Rather than rapturing "lukewarm...miserable" Christians (Rev 3:17), we should expect "the Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple...But who may abide the day of his coming...for he is like a refiner's fire," Malachi 3:1,2. If we are faithful through this refining process (trumpet plagues of Revelation 8,9, the mark of the New World Order (Revelation 13:16,17) and the 7 vials that fall on those who receive that mark (Revelation 14:9,10; Rev 16) we will be ready to meet Christ when He comes visibly ("every eye shall see Him, Rev 1:7, Revelation 19:11).

Camping rightly uses "a thousand years are as a day." (2Peter 3:8) but he dates the Flood at 4990 BC, a thousand years off 4004 BC which millions of King James Bibles have for the creation, based on Ussher's Chronology and approximated by Sir Isaac Newton.

Astronomy confirms Newton: "May 5, 2000: The date that Mercury, Venus, Mars, Jupiter and Saturn will line up with the sun and moon, the first time in 6000 years." *TIME Magazine*, Jan 17, 2000.

That supports Genesis 1:14 when God put "lights in the sky for signs and seasons" as being 6,000 years ago (and creation as 4000 BC). But Camping's error in calculation is offset by his choice to use 7,000 years versus the Bible's giving man six days (Exodus 20:9) and 6,000 years. Speaking of the day of judgment, "one day *is* with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day," 2 Peter 3:8.

The Bible has a solar system alignment in which the sun, moon and stars "made obeisance" to Joseph who was sold as a slave to Egypt, but after seven good years, his brothers bowed to him like the stars in his dream during seven bad years that followed.

Since 2000, we had seven good years, but in 2008, troubles came and we could be flirting with the beginning of the bad years. Reasons for a judgment day (but not the end of the world) on May 26, 2011 are posted at http://MayJudgmentDay.com

Coincidence or Could May 26, like the end of Noah's week, be HUGE? A HUGE earthquake May 26 would mean it's Christ's "knock" in Luke 12:36. We forget the Old Testament model when God took Israel from calamity in Egypt to a covenant relationship at Sinal and later said, "I am married to you," Jeremiah 3:14.

The Bible's best theologian (Paul) includes the Exodus when he wrote, "All those things happened unto them for [types] and they are written for our admonition upon whom the ends of the world are come." 1Corinthians 10:1,11.

We are living amid unprecedented calamities. Calamities are a time of crisis. The Chinese character crisis are two: danger + opportunity. The Greek word, krisis, is translated "judgment" in Revelation 14:7.

A time of judgment is impending and what we do in a crisis can determine our destiny. It did for Israel as they left Egypt and bondage for the land that God promised to give Abraham and his seed.

When He got ready to do so, **God attacked the gods of Egypt**. They worshiped the Nile; it turned to blood. They worshiped cattle; they got disease. 

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A Prediction for 2011, May 19?

Like cross-hairs on a gun sight, two timelines intersect on May 19, 2011.

May 19, 1780 was a historic "Dark Day" in New England. "The darkness was so complete that candles were required from noon on. It did not disperse until the middle of the next night."

Many took the unexplained darkness as an apocalyptic sign. (Wikipedia)

The anniversary 200 years later, May 19, 1980 was another dark day as ash from Mt St Helens erupting May 18, spread over three northwestern states. Mere coincidence?

Dr. Richard Ruhling, author and Bible conference speaker believes God was marking May 19 as suggested: "the day of the Lord…a day of darkness and gloominess, a day of clouds and thick darkness," Zeph 1:14,15. For the second timeline is based on Christ's words, "You don't know the day or hour" which have been misunderstood. The Greek word, eido, means, consider, perceive, understand. Christ was saying, You don't understand, and each time he said it, he gave an example that fit a provision in their law for Passover a month later, "as in the days of Noah," when the Flood (calamity) came at Passover time, but in the second spring month.

Jewish law also specified a late Passover if you were away on a trip (Numbers 9:10,11). Christ introduced his last parable by saying, "You don't know...watch, for the kingdom of heaven is as a man traveling to a far

country..." Could he be returning for some judgment at second Passover?

Passover was the context of when judgment fell on Egypt, Jericho, Sodom, and also on Christ.

His teaching supports the possibility that when the judgment comes to America, it could fit these clues. This year the 2nd Passover falls on May 19, a date already marked (above). Time will tell.

Passover is a Jewish event, but Christians should "watch and pray" on the evening of May 18 that God will pass over us in any judgment that falls. But maybe like Elijah, we should pray that God will bring judgment to America to turn us to Him. Can we really pray, God bless America when we kicked Him out of class rooms and court rooms?

Christ wants us hot or cold, and events are coming that will drive us to Him or away. Every cloud has a silver lining and Christ's wedding parables offer the highest possible reward—"He will make [us] ruler over all that He has" if we open immediately to His "knock," Luke 12:36,44.

Comparing Scriptures to understand them, the only other place where Christ "knocks" is for the church of Laodicea and it ended in an earthquake in 63 AD; type and antitype?

Ellen White foresaw similar possibilities for us when she said, "It seemed that...Judgment day had come," in her earthquake vision at Loma Linda. Some readers think she was merely reporting the San Francisco Earthquake, but she added, "Through His prophet Zephaniah, the Lord specifies judgments He will bring...in the day of the Lord's sacrifice." 9T 93,95, citing Zeph 1:8.

"The day of the Lord's sacrifice" is Passover. That's when God said, "I will execute judgment," Exod 12:12. At Passover Christ prayed the cup pass [over/from] Him, but He asked His disciples to "watch [be awake is the meaning of the Greek word, gregoreo] and pray." And He tells us, "If you don't watch, I will come on you as a thief." Rev 3:3

A thief comes when we don't expect him, but God said He won't do anything without revealing it, Amos 3:7. And the next verse is about the earthquake is you compare a lion's roar with Joel 3:16, and the Lion of Judah, Rev 5:5.

Each time Christ said You don't know the day or hour, He gave an example that fit a provision in their law for Passover a month later, as for travel in Numbers 9:10,11.

Note His reference to the "goodman" in Matt 24:43, KJV. The only Old Testament reference to "goodman" is Prov 7:18-20. A harlot says, "let us take our fill of love...for the goodman is not at home, he is gone a long journey. He... will come home at the yom kece [full moon]."

Passover comes on a full moon, but "long journey" means Passover a month later. Last year, this passage applied as Pope Benedict (goodman) was "gone a long journey" to Jerusalem, arriving "at the yom kece," full moon of 2nd Passover, and he is married to the harlot in Rev 17:1.

The point is, we are seeing what Ellen White said, "the types that relate to the 2nd advent must be fulfilled at the time pointed out in the symbolic service." GC 399. But, if we aren't looking at those appointed times, we can miss seeing or understanding their application.

This is important, because the next time Christ gave an example pointing to 2nd Passover, it was in connection with His own coming as Bridegroom, "for the kingdom of heaven is as a man traveling to a far country" Matt 25:14.

"Till heaven and earth pass, not one jot or tittle will pass from the law." Matt 5:18. Even His return in judgment to separate wise from foolish, lukewarm to hot or cold, will be in conformity to His appointed times, COL 34, GC 399. Paul said they were "shadows of things to come." Col 2:17

"As the days of Noah" also had 2nd Passover timing. Noah entered ark on 10th day; compare Gen 7:4,11 and Exod 12:3.

Please consider watching (being awake) and praying as Christ said as 2nd Passover begins the evening of April 29.

We should be ready, "that when he comes and knocks, [we] may open unto him immediately," Luke 12:36. How do we "open immediately"? By keeping the feast of unleavened bread that begins then, as suggested by the imagery of the next verse when Christ served His disciples and gave them unleavened bread, Luke 12:37.

But this is not about bread; bread represents spiritual truth in the Bible, Matt 16:12. Communion with Christ in His word is how we become one with Him. We also become one with Him by making a covenant. These superimpose at Passover. That's how Israel did it and God later said, "I am married unto you," Jer 3:14. When did they get married? They got married at Sinai when they made a covenant.

God took Israel from calamity in Egypt through the sea to a covenant at Sinai where they became His kingdom and His bride. Paul says, "All those things happened to them for ex-amples [margin, types*]...ends of the world," 1Cor 10:1,11.

*This means we look forward to similar circumstances.

The key is our understanding that we can marry Christ as our Bridegroom by making a covenant with Him. Ellen White's last definition of church is a "covenant-keeping people…and to them will be fulfilled all the covenant promises made by [God to Israel], PK 713,714.

In considering our need to make a covenant with God, only that which comes from God can lead to God.

Bible covenants were linked to sevens. "Covenant" is found 7 times in Gen 9. Abraham gave Abimelek 7 lambs, Gen 21:27,28. God gave Israel 7 holy days, Lev 23. In the covenant that we must make with Christ, we need to see a collection of topics that He has emphasized 7 times as a mark of end-time truth for us.

For example, the statutes, judgments and sabbaths are emphasized 7 times in Ezekiel 20:11-24. As Adventists we have focused on the Sabbath as a sign, but we cut the "s" off of Sabbaths and fail to see the statutes and judgments as anything to remember.God says, "Remember the law of Moses…with the statutes and judgments. Behold I send you Elijah…" Mal 4:4,5. Christ said Elijah "shall first come, and restore all things," Matt 17:11.

Dr. Roy Gane, President of Adventist Theological Society, and professor at Andrews Univ, presented "The Gospel According to Moses and Elijah" and it was a focus on the statutes and judgments cited in Mal 4:4,5. (Dec, 2009)

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Entering the End-times?

Our Sunday School class offers an alternate focus on an issue of current relevance. Last year one discussion featured a study of Mark 1:15:

"The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel."

Each of these phrases may have a new and deeper meaning...

The time is fulfilled. Peter would say, "beloved, be not ignorant...one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. The Lord is not slack...the day of the Lord will come." 2 Pet 3:8-10. Pioneers believed that the end-time apocalyptic period, "the day of the Lord," would come after 6,000 years because God gives man six days to do all his work, Exodus 20:9.

Ussher's Chronology supports 6,000 years as completed by 2000 AD, confirmed by Sir Isaac Newton's chronology and also by science:

"May 5, 2000: The date that Mercury, Venus, Mars, Jupiter and Saturn [lined up] with the sun and moon—the first time in 6,000 years." TIME Magazine, Jan 17, 2000.

That was ten years ago; why is it relevant now? Because of the context of the Bible's solar system alignment. "The sun, moon and stars made obeisance" to Joseph. His brothers didn't like his dreams and they sold him as a slave. But after seven good years, there were seven bad years when his brothers came and bowed to him like the stars in his dream. Since 2000, we had seven good years, but the seven bad years may have started in 2008.
