About Us.

The Humanitarian New Thought Movement (HNT) is dedicated to promoting world peace, transcending current models of human sociological, technological development. The HNT transcends all boundaries, with a belief that peace and the capability of humanity begins in the mind of each individual. The HNT believes that with the cultivation of each new thought and action that a being chooses to activate and create will bring with it an effect.

The Movement was established in 2006 whilst cooperating and working with grass-roots organizations and Peace networks. In recognition of Luke Simmons' peace building efforts he was named The Voice of Peace in 2010 by Voice for Peace a Peace network that operates in The Bajaur Agency (FATA).
