Mackenzie was the 64th most popular name for girls born in the United States in 2007. This spelling of the name was also among the top 1,000 most popular names for American boys from 1980 to 2001. It was last ranked among the top 1,000 names for boys in the United States in 2001.^[2] Alternate spelling McKenzie was the 161st most popular name for girls born in 2007 in the United States.^[3]

Variations

Variations of the given name *Mackenzie* include: *Makenzie*, *Mackynzie*, *Makensie*,^[1] *Mickenzie* and *Mckenzie*.^[4] Reduced forms of *Mackenzie* are *Mack*, *Kenz* and *Kenzie*.^[5]

The names are anglicised forms of the Scottish Gaelic *MacCoinnich*, which is a patronymic form of the personal name *Coinneach*, anglicised as Kenneth or *son of the fair one*. The name is thought to have come from Ulster in Ireland and is part of the Ulaidh and is a branch of the family of Mac Mathghamha (McMahon).
