- **NEBOW** (iבְב): Hebrew form of Babylonian <u>Nabu</u>, meaning "Mercury" and "prophet." In the bible, this is the Hebrew name for a Babylonian deity who presided over learning and letters. It is also the name of a city in Moab, a city in Judah, and the name of the mountain where Moses died....
- NEVO: Variant spelling of Hebrew <u>Nebo</u>, meaning "Mercury" and "prophet."
