Nibhaz

Nibhaz (Hebrew for "*the barker*")^{[1][2]} was a deity of the **Avim** during the time of **Shalmaneser I** (**2 Kings 17:31**). Some indications of worship have been found in **Syria**, between **Berytus** and **Tripolis**, in the form of a dog.^{[1][2]}
