- Act 9:3 Now as he [Paul] was going along and approaching Damascus, suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him.
- Act 9:4 He fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?"
- Act 9:5 He asked, "Who are you, Lord?" The reply came, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting.
- Act 9:6 But get up and enter the city, and you will be told what you are to do."
- Act 9:7 The men who were traveling with him stood speechless because they heard the voice but saw no one.
- Act 9:8 Saul got up from the ground, and though his eyes were open, he could see nothing; so they led him by the hand and brought him into Damascus.
- Act 9:9 For three days he was without sight, and neither ate nor drank.
- Act 22:6 "While I [Paul] was on my way and approaching Damascus, about noon a great light from heaven suddenly shone about me.
- Act 22:7 I fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to me, 'Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?'
- Act 22:8 I answered, 'Who are you, Lord?' Then he said to me, 'I am Jesus of Nazareth whom you are persecuting.'
- Act 22:9 Now those who were with me saw the light but did not hear the voice of the one who was speaking to me.

Act 22:10 I asked, 'What am I to do, Lord?' The Lord said to me, 'Get up and go to Damascus; there you will be told everything that has been assigned to you to do.' Act 22:11 Since I could not see because of the brightness of that light, those who were with me took my hand and led me to Damascus.
