R-Ḥ-M

R-Ḥ-M (Arabic: ر ح م, Hebrew: רחם) is the triconsonantal root of many Arabic and Hebrew words, and many of those words are used as names. It indicates mercy and sympathy.

Usages

Words

- raḥam (Arabic: رحم, rexem Hebrew: רחם): "womb".
- raḥ-m-mahh (Arabic: رحمة, raxamim Hebrew: רחמי): "caring; cares, mercy".

The Arabic stems

- raḥima: "be mild, care, have mercy"
- raḥḥama: "care for, feel sympathy for"
- istirḥama: "beg for mercy"

The Hebrew stems

- raxam: "care, be mild, have mercy, have tender affection, have compassion"
- raxum: "mildhearted, softhearted, compassionate"
- raxmani: "mild, meek, careful, merciful, compassionate"
- raxmi: "womb"

Names

Names given to God

- al-Rahman: "The Most Gracious"^[1] or "Beneficent"
- al-Rahim: "The Merciful"

Human given names

- Abdur Rahman: "servant of al-Rahman"
 - Raheem ^[2], Raheema ^[3], Rahema ^[4], Rahim ^[5], Rahima ^[6], Rahimah ^[7], Rakhim ^[8]
 - Rachman ^[9], Rahman ^[10], Rakhman ^[11]
 - Rachmaninov

Avraham Ben-Raḥamiël Qanaï (אברהם בן-רהמיאל קנאי) is the leader of the Congregation Oraḥ Şaddiqim in Albany, New York, and a proponent of Karaite Judaism in the United States. He is considered a Ḥakham in the Karaite Jewish community.

Qanaï practiced naturopathy and osteopathic manipulative medicine in Troy, New York. He is branch secretary of the James Connolly Upstate New York Regional GMB, Industrial Workers of the World of Albany, New York.

His father was named Raḥamiël Ben-Yosef Bölekçan. Qanaï studied with several Karaite scholars, including 'Immanu'el Ben-Mosheh Mass'ouda, David Yerushalmi, Ḥayyim Levi, Eliyahu Marzouq, Mosheh Dabbah, Yosef El-Gamil, and Zekharyah Raḥamim Levi. It was Ḥakham 'Immanu'el that bestowed the title of Ḥakham upon Qanaï. Wikipedia:Citation needed

Ḥakham Qanaï has intensively promoted Karaite scholarship. Wikipedia:Citation needed He is a co-author of the book *An Introduction to Karaite Judaism: History, Theology, Practice and Custom*, which discusses historical and modern Karaite Judaism.
