## Salem (name)

Salem (Arabic: שלה, properly transliterated as *Sālim*; it can also be a transliteration of the Hebrew: שֶׁלֶם *Shalem*; <sup>[1]</sup> the Arabic name is also transliterated as *Salim*) is an Arabic given name and surname, a Sephardic Jewish surname of Hebrew origin, <sup>[2][3]</sup> and an English origin surname. <sup>[4]</sup>

In addition, when transliterated the name Salim (Arabic:  $\omega$ ), can become indistinguishable in English, as the spelling *Salim* is also used, though with a short a and a long i sounds.
