Samuil (Semil, “heard of God”)—in Jewish legendary lore, an angel of the earth—that is, one who exercises dominion over the earth. In *Enoch II*, 33, he is the angel who not only transported Enoch to Heaven (while Enoch was still in the flesh) but, as commanded by God, returned him to earth—although this mission and feat are also ascribed to other angels, among them Rasuil and Anafiel.
