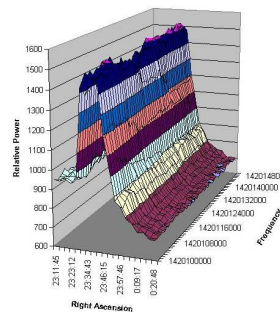
Our Members Scan the Skies
