

Usiel (Uziel, Uzziel) - (“strength of God”). in the cabala generally, as in Targum Onkeles and Jonathan, Usiel is an angel that fell, and is therefore evil; he was among those who wedded human wives and begat giants. Of the 10 unholy sefiroth, Usiel is listed 5th. In the Book of the Angel Raziel, Usiel (Uzziel) is among the 7 angels before the throne of God and among 9 set over the 4 winds. Usiel replaces Uriel in the reprint English translation of Verus Jesuitarum Libellus (“True Magical Work of the Jesuits”). The Key to Faust’s Threefold Harrowing of Hell (otherwise known as a Key to Black Raven) contains a general conjuration to Usiel and a list of his adjutant princes. Finally, according to Milton, Usiel is a good angel, of the order of virtues, a lieutenant of Gabriel’s in the fighting in Heaven at the time of Satan’s defection.

USIEL

Usiel (Strength of God) is generally considered a fallen angel and among those who wedded human wives and begat giants. He is also listed as the fifth of the ten unholy sefiroth. According to the Book of the Angel Raziel, Usiel is among the seven angels before the throne of God, and among the nine set over the four winds. A conjuration of Usiel and an accounting of his adjunct princes are found in The Key to Faust's Threefold Harrowing of Hell. Milton regards Usiel as an "unfallen" angel, belonging to the order of virtues, as well as one of Gabriel's lieutenants during Satan's rebellion.

Uzziel

This article is about the biblical figure. For the Mishnah rabbi, see Jonathan ben Uzziel.

According to the Torah, **Uzziel** (Hebrew: עֲזִיֵּאל, ʿŪzîʿēl, meaning *El is my strength* or *God is my strength*^[1]) was the father of Mishael, Elzaphan, and Zithri, and was a son of Kohath and grandson of Levi, consequently being the brother of Amram and uncle of Aaron, Miriam, and Moses. Uzziel is portrayed in the text as the founder of the *Uzzielite* faction of Levites; however, despite Uzziel supposedly being Kohath's son, and Elzaphan's father, on some occasions the Book of Chronicles treats the *Uzzielites* as being quite distinct from the descendants of Kohath, and from those of Elzaphan.

No further details of Uzziel's life are given by the Bible, and according to bible critics, the genealogy for Levi's descendants is actually an aetiological myth, reflecting popular perception of the connections between different Levite factions;^[2] textual "scholars" attribute the genealogy to the Book of Generations, a document originating from a similar religiopolitical group and date to the priestly source.^[3]
