Zephaniah (Zephemiah, Zephaniel—"Jehovah hides")—in rabbinic literature, chief of the order of ishim, which is the 2nd hierarchic order in the 10 orders of the cabala. [*Rf. Ginzberg, The Legends of the Jews VI, 236.*] Zephaniah, by the way, is a name for the witch (or, more correctly, the diviner) of Endor. [*See Sedecla.*]
