Guru Nanak according to the Supreme Bahá'í body, the Universal House of Justice, *was endowed with a "saintly character"* [Universal House of Justice. Letter dated 27 October, 1985 to the National Spiritual Assembly of the Bahá'ís of India] and *"was inspired to reconcile the religions of Hinduism and Islam, the followers of which religions had been in violent conflict."* The Bahá'ís thus view Guru Nanak as a *'saint of the highest order'*.
